

The GMWEA is:

A not-for-profit association of water supply and wastewater treatment personnel formed in 1993. GMWEA represents a variety of water quality interests including water and wastewater treatment, industrial treatment (dairy, metals, pulp and paper), water distribution, biosolids management and stormwater.

GMWEA is an educational and technical organization that promotes the protection and enhancement of our water environment.

GMWEA provides:

- ◆ Annual Spring and Fall Meetings, which offer members technical training sessions, awards programs and participation in officer elections. The Fall Meeting also includes a trade show which features environmental related equipment and services.
- ◆ Regular training sessions for members on water quality topics such as math, laboratory, safety, distribution and collection systems and Sacramento courses. Training resources are enhanced by GMWEA's affiliation with the New England Water Environment Association, the New England Water Works Association and the New England Interstate Water Pollution Control Association.

In addition, cooperative efforts with the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources, the Vermont Rural Water Association, the Vermont League of Cities and Towns and local facilities provide nearby resources to carry out necessary operator training.

- ◆ A quarterly newsletter, the *GMWEA News*, brings regulatory updates and association news to all members. These issues include such things as classifieds, training calendars, equipment exchange, interesting articles as well as upcoming events.
- ◆ GMWEA officers and members regularly provide state and federal officials with input on regulations having an impact on the profession.
